Instructions for Applying to the Bachelor of Social Work Program

Step 1: Apply online to Yukon University

- <u>https://www.yukonu.ca/admissions/apply</u> Create account and login
- Select "Partnership Degrees" then select Bachelor of Social Work as the program
- Submit your official transcripts to Yukon University Admissions
- Pay your admission fee

Step 2: Complete the BSW Application and email it by March 31, 2023

- 1. Checklist of academic prerequisites
- 2. A written personal statemen; follow the guidelines provided
- 3. A list of three references. Reference forms are provided
- 4. A Vulnerable Sector Criminal Record Check
- 5. A current resume that includes work and volunteer experience
- 6. Forward your completed application by email or mail:

Step 3: Applications Screened by Yukon University Admissions

Completed BSW admission applications are typically screened by Yukon University Admissions within four weeks of receipt. Yukon University Admissions determines if the applications are complete and meet minimum criteria. Applications that meet the admission criteria are



forwarded to the BSW Admissions Coordinator for additional review. Applicants who do not meet admission criteria will be notified.

Step 4: BSW Interview

Applicants who meet the admission criteria will be interviewed by program faculty and community-based social workers in April and early May. Applicants must achieve a satisfactory interview score to be accepted to the program. Seats are limited and half the seats are reserved for Indigenous applicants who meet the admission criteria.

Step 5: Decisions about admission

Applicants who were interviewed will be informed by Yukon University Admissions about the outcome of their application.

Step 6: Successful applicants

There is a mandatory orientation session. Registration with the University of Regina, transfer credit and registration in Yukon University social work courses will be discussed at this time.

Applicants must have completed a minimum of 30 university credits prior to admission to the BSW and obtained a minimum GPA of 70%. A 70% combined average is required for the two English courses. English language proficiency is required.

2. Personal Statement

A personal statement is an opportunity to demonstrate that you have given careful thought to your reasons for wanting a social work education, what might be inspirational or challenging, and the type and degree of support you may need while you are a student.

Your personal statement will be read only by BSW faculty

Please address the following questions in your personal statement. (Max 2000 words.)

- a) Why have you chosen to pursue a social work education?
- b) What does social justice mean to you?
- c) Describe a social issue that you have experienced with. How does it relate to social work? In what ways does this experience motivate you to become a social worker?
- d) Social work education can be both positively engaging and challenging. What challenges might you experience? Which supports might you need?

3. Criminal Record Check

A Vulnerable Sector Criminal Record Check is required. Applicants request this review from the RCMP and deliver the completed form to Yukon University Admissions, Attention: BSW Program Application

4. <u>References</u>

Applicants are required to submit three (3) references in support of their application. The references must have known you for a minimum of one year.

Two (2) of the references must be from people who have known you through your employment, volunteer work, or education. One (1) reference can be from someone who knows you on a personal basis but is not a relative.

Provide your referee with the following documents:
